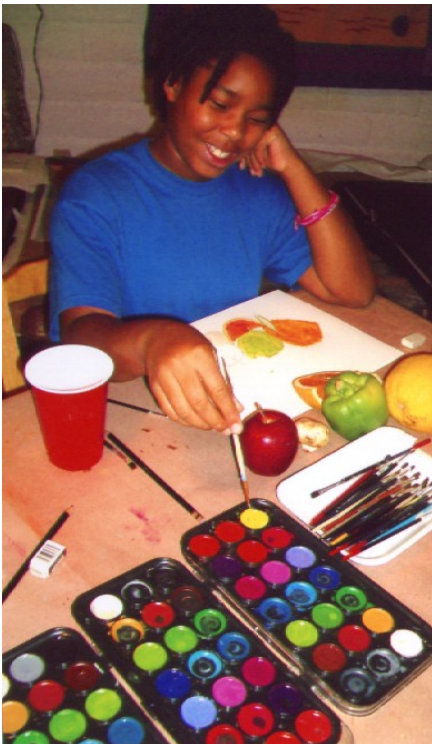




Budding Artists

Projects will include:- drawing, painting, 3D sculpture, textiles, picture-book construction, still life, self portraits, mixed media and collage.

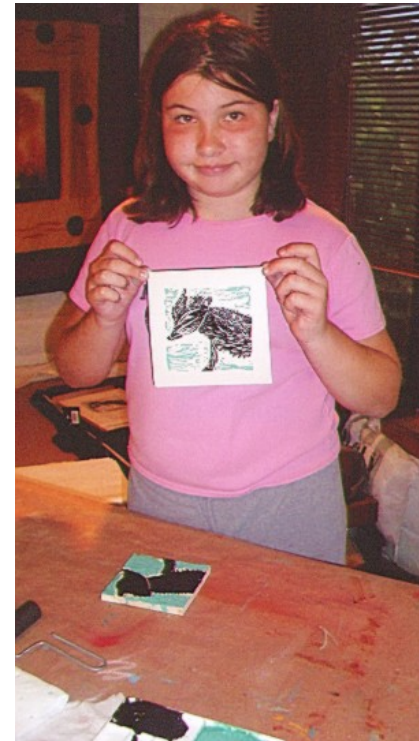


Young Artists

Designed for the young artist with developed skills and a passion for art making. The classes offer scope for the participants to refine their abilities and hone areas that will improve their art pieces.

This workshop will provide creative stimulation for your child along with expanding their knowledge of art history and a diverse range of creative methods.

Projects include:- formal art theory, structured art history modules, drawing, painting, mixed media and 3D sculpture. Attention will be given to increasing the participants confidence with still life, portraiture, drawing and the various painting mediums.





Spirited Teens

This workshop responds to the maturity of creatively adventurous youth. Each session will offer a balance between enhancing the participants understanding of art, artists and cultural representation.

Projects undertaken will include:-
Advanced use of materials, experimental forms of art making, mixed media, classic use of painting and drawing, design and illustration and large scale artworks.

This workshop is designed for mature teenagers who can develop an art portfolio, suitable for school applications.
